We'll be viewing seven great 21st-century films made in Bosnia, Czechia, Poland, Hungary, Macedonia, and Romania. Their themes encompass satirical tales about the Cold War (1945-1989), modern-day family dramas about migrant labor in the EU and the choice between religious and secular lifestyles, and a wonderful story about honeybees saving the planet. Films include Jan Hřebejk's *Divided We Fall*, Paweł Pawlikowski's *Ida*, *Tales from the Golden Age* – a series of sketches by five Romanian directors, and Tamara Kotevska & Ljubomir Stefanov's *Honeyland*.
